

BOOTH CONFIGURATIONS - PERIMETER BOOTH

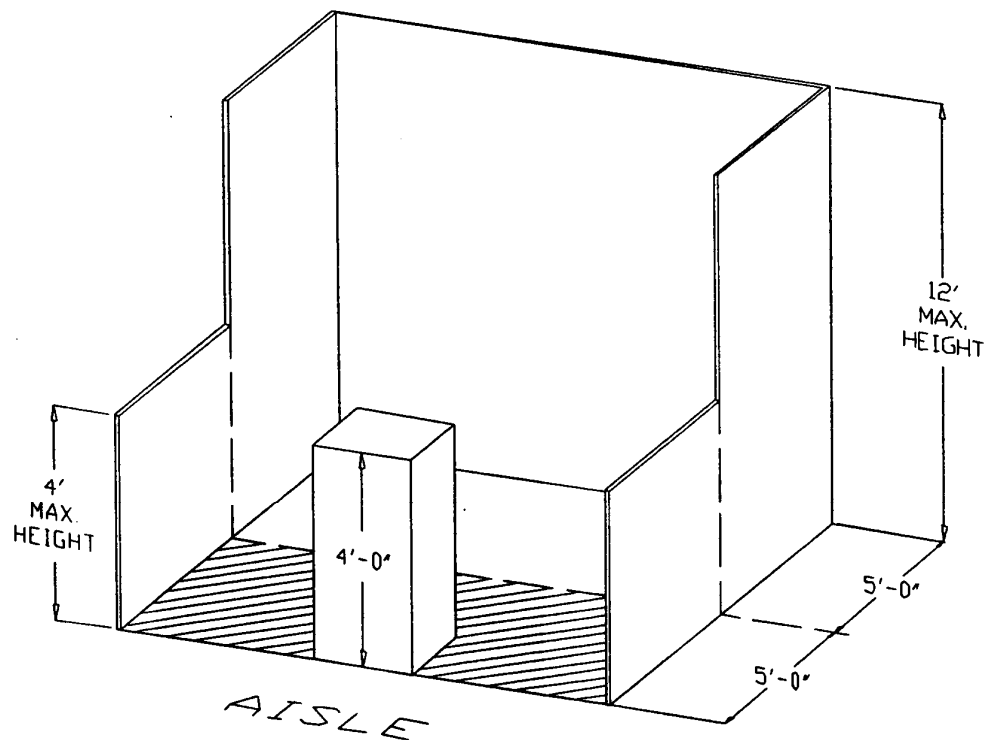
Perimeter Booth

A perimeter booth is a linear booth that backs to a wall of the exhibit facility rather than another exhibit.

Perimeter booths are 10 feet (10') wide and 10 feet (10') deep with a back wall height limitation of 12 feet (12') which includes all fixtures and signs.

The maximum height of 12 feet (12') is allowed only in the rear half of the booth space, with a 4-foot (4') height restriction imposed on all materials in the remaining space forward to the aisle. This is to ensure that the sightlines of neighboring exhibits are not obstructed.

No hanging signs are permitted in perimeter booths.



Important

Space dimensions shown on floor plan are from the centerline of booth equipment, such as side rails and/or back drape. Exhibit structures must be constructed to allow sufficient tolerance and for utility service at the rear of the booth.
